Our Campus: Infrastructure & Facilities

Big Size Play Ground & Children's Park

Our aim is to make our campus plastic-free. We have created a breathing greenery space for our children for recreation, games and physical exercises. Swings are available for children . This area also has a wide range of vegetation.

Gymnasium

Gym workouts are one of the best ways to stay healthy and fit, and increase the energy level. We are proud to possess a state-of-the-art gymnasium where highly qualified instructors design appropriate fitness plans for the students tailored towards their specific needs.



Ultra Modern Transport Facility

A fleet of school buses operate on various routes to ferry children to school at very nominal charges and commuters are fully insured. The school buses cover almost all the areas of the city. The students are escorted by teachers for safety.





Hostel / Boarding Houses

The school has exclusive hostels separately for Boys and Girls equipped with all the amenities and facilities. The rooms and dormitories are spacious and airy. Toilets are scrupulously cleaned regularly and follow all hygiene standards. We provide affordable, high quality accommodation that provides a rich and balanced living and learning environment. Students are encouraged to choose a form of accommodation that suits a healthy life style.

Housemasters are the pastoral heads of the houses. They are assisted by assistant housemasters, tutors and resident dames. A housemaster looks after the academic and extra-curricular performance of the boys and girls in his house, whereas the resident dame of a house is responsible for their hygiene and other household matters. The senior boys of the house are expected to help their juniors and the newly admitted students to adjust to the new environment and routine.

Medical Facility

Health of the children is adequately monitored in the school. The school has a medical room fully equipped with first aid, in case of any emergency. The students are periodically examined by ENT, and dental specialists and records maintained are shared with their parents. In case of any illness, the parents and guardians of the child are kept informed about the treatment being given.

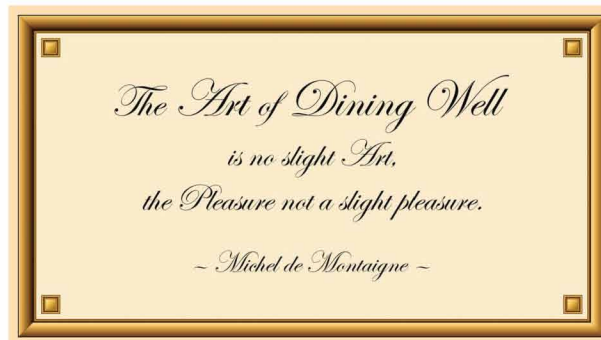
Dining Hall / Mess

Vegetarian and non-vegetarian food is supplied to students as per demand of the season. Milk is served daily. The Mess Menu includes Indian, Continental and Chinese. 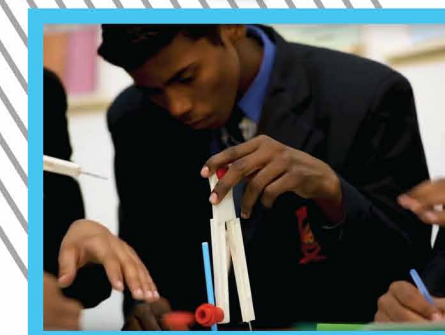
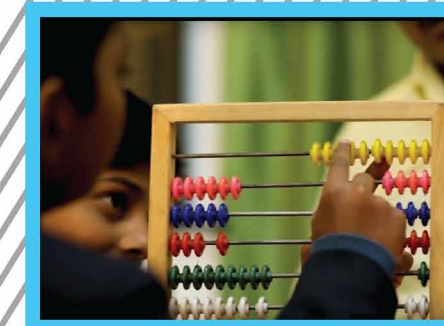

Residential School

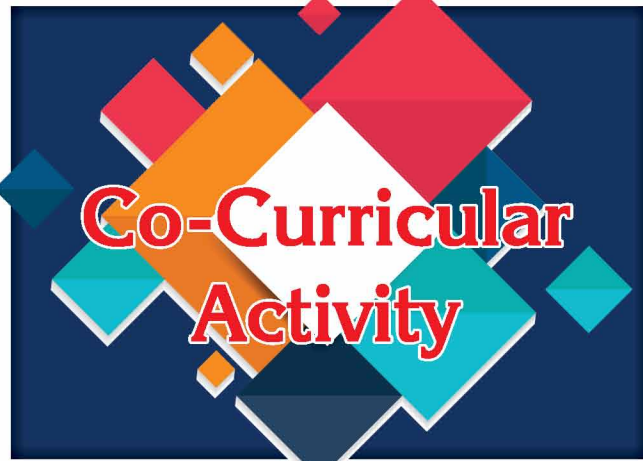
It offers the child an opportunity to grow and flower as an individual into a confident person with a well groomed personality who makes his own mark without any consideration of parent's economic and social status.

Adventure activities like trekking, camping and rock climbing are also organised with the aim of promoting self confidence and leadership qualities among the students.



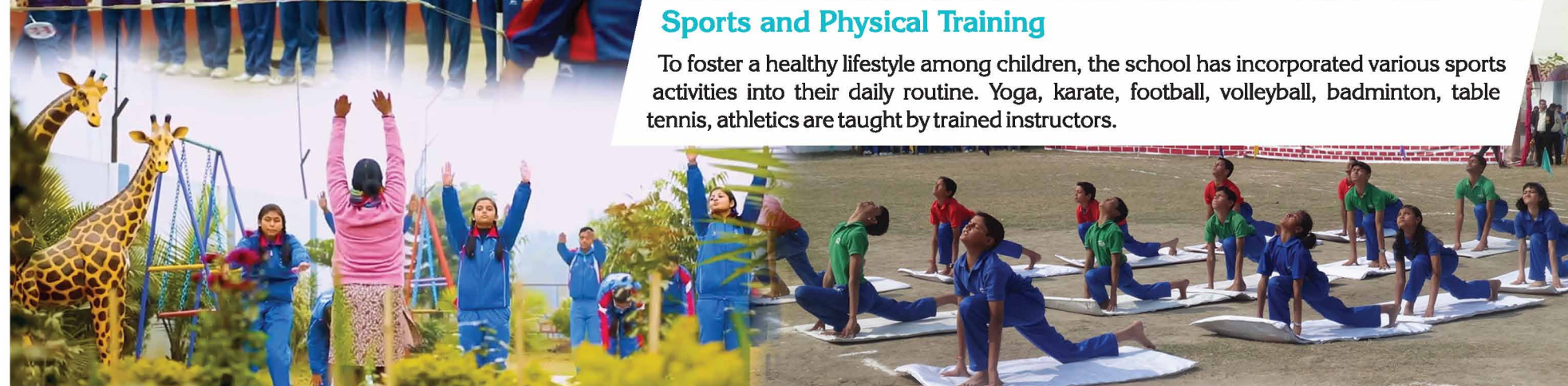

Sports and Physical Training

Registration and Admission

Registration

Registration is the first step to get admission in school. Day-Boarding facilities are available for girls and boarding for boys. For admission a child must be registered latest by the first week of January. The academic session begins from the month of April. Registration in no way ensures the admission. Only registered candidates will be considered for admission.

Admission

Doon Public School follows the guidelines of R.T.E 2010. After registration candidates will be notified of the date of Admission Test and Interview. The Admission committee reserves the right to select the candidate based on their performance in the written test, interview and their aptitude, personality, intelligence and other capabilities. The decision of the committee will be final and abiding in all classes.

Admission to L.K.G and U.KG will be through interaction and observation .

Withdrawals

Parents withdrawing their child in the middle of the term will not be entitled to any refund of fees. Parents who decide to discontinue the education from the next term must give prior notice in writing, which should reach the principal not less than 75 days before the start of the next session. Failing this the security deposits and fees will be forfeited.

Scholarship

We endeavour to give meritorious students the benefit of an all round education by providing financial assistance. Scholarship ranging from 20% to 30% is available on the basis of merit of the student .

Fee & Fines

Transfer Certificate will not be issued without clearance of dues. Broken periods are not allowed under any circumstances, fee will be charged for the entire session, irrespective of student's attendance. No reduction of fee on the account of any holiday, forced closure or temporary absence whatsoever.

All charges deducted against imprest money are charged on actual and each bill is counter signed by the child. For any other enquiry or detail the accounts section may be contacted.

Late Fee Charges

In the event of school fee not being deposited by writam the due date, a grace period of 15 days will be given, However after due date an interest of 24% per annum of the school fee will be charged for boarder students.

In case of a Day-Boarder student after 5 days of due date Rs 20/- per day will be charged.

Bank Charges

All bank charges pertaining to remittance of school fee, if any, shall be debited to the student's account.

In the event of bank draft / cheque being dishonoured a sum Rs 500/- will be charged extra beside the bank charges.

Medical Expenses

Expenses incurred on specialist medical treatment / transport / out of school treatment / hospitalization will be charged extra as per actual.

Refund of Security Amount

Security amount is refundable and will be refunded after six month of withdrawal of child only on written request from the parents . The refund of security fee will only be given if the child passes class X or XII. In case the child is withdrawn before that security will not be refunded. The refund of security deposit is subject to clearance of the all dues. Security deposit will not be adjusted against pending dues. At the time of claiming refund of security deposits, the parent/guardian must produce the original receipts of deposits of caution money.

Sibling Rebate

Second child of the same parents is eligible for 10% rebate in the school fee. The rebate shall be withdrawn upon one of the brother / sister passes out / withdrawn from the school.



Rules & Regulation for Residential Students

General Code of Conduct

- Boarder should follow the daily routine of the hostel.
- No Hostellers will be allowed to stay back in their rooms or in the hostel Premises during the school time .
- No one is allowed to keep more than 200 in cash in the possession and no valuable things should be possessed by them while staying in hostel.
- Any Hosteller is not allowed to keep medicine without valid prescription by a Doctor .
- No Hosteller is allowed to keep transistor ,Record player and Tape-recorder, Guitar or any such thing which may disturb the other students .
- Electrical gadgets like, laptop ear phone ,heater, iron etc is banned in the hostel.
- Night Roll –call will be taken by warden/ H s at 10:30 pm in summer and 10:00 pm in winter.
- Report card will be sent by the Hostel superintendent to Parent.
- All boarders will write a letter twice in a month to their parents.
- Any Hosteller is not allowed to call their Day-scholar friend to hostel premises for their personal interaction.
- All Hostellers should make their telephone call as per the telephone schedule.
- No Hosteller is not allowed to keep long hair.
- If a child is absent for more than a week without any information or prior permission his/her name will be struck off the rolls.
- No boarder is allowed to change his/her status and become a day boarder.

Rules for Visitors and Outing

- Visitors list must be filled in duplicate by parents with utmost care and thought. Change if any must be intimated in writing to the principal.
- No staff member, whether matron or teaching staff is permitted to be the local guardian. Only parents are allowed to take the child for outing. No other person is allowed.
- Only person whose name is on the visitors list will be permitted to meet and take the child out.
- Any visitor is not allowed to go inside the dormitory.
- In case of any emergency, parents may meet to their ward any day with the principal's permission.

Reporting After Vacation

- All students are supposed to report back to school on due date.
- Students reporting late from vacations, outing and leave are liable to a fine of Rs 100 per days.
- Students must report between 1pm to 7pm in summer season and 1 pm to 6 pm in winter.
- If the reason for the delay is a medical one , parents must bring the child back personally with all supporting medical certificates.

Leave Policy

No permission for small rites except outing: students are only allowed for three days leave to attend a wedding of his/her brother and sister, but not during examination or any type of assessment .

Telephone Calls

- The school does not permit students to have mobile phones.
- The assigned days for telephone calls is Saturday.
- In case of any difficulty or emergency, the parent may call the House master or the Hostel superintendent at the cell number provided by school.

Appeal to the Parents

Parents and teachers have a common goal of bringing an all round development in the personality — physical, mental and moral, of the child. Therefore parents are requested to observe the rules of the hostel for holistic development of children.

Guidelines and rules for parents are mentioned below :

- Mobile, laptop or any other kind of electronic gadgets are not allowed in the hostel.
- Children should be sent to the school after vacation on the reopening day of the school.
- If children report late to school after vacation or leave without valid reason, parents are liable to pay Rs. 100/- fine per day.
- It is recommended not to ask for leave for the child for social functions like marriage / religious rites / rituals and so on when the session is on.
 - Do not pamper your child with presents or money. Your child or ward can be the best, just ask him to work hard.
 - You are requested to visit school only on the fourth or last Sunday of every month only from 11 am to 2:00 p.m. Parents may meet to Hostel Superintendent / Vice Principal / Principal during their visit to school.
- Dormitories are forbidden area; you may meet your ward at reception only.
- Parents/ Guardian whose names are registered can only meet the child.
- Parents are requested not to call on any teacher or staff's mobile for the purpose of talking. You are requested to make a call at reception only.
- Students are not allowed to keep cash of more than Rs. 200/-.
- Students are supposed to deposit their valuable to Hostel Superintendent.
- This is mandatory for every parent to give the details of medical history of their wards.
- Outside eatables are not permitted inside the hostel.
- Please see that there are no dues outstanding against your ward before vacation. Please avoid giving cash to your ward.



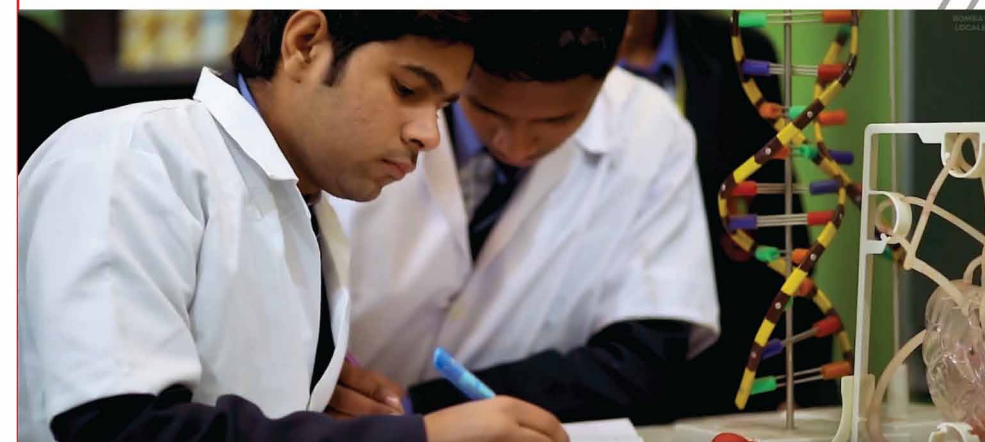
Doon Old Students Association (DOSA) :

All the above bad behaviour will lead to accumulation of bad points. This will lead to disciplinary action in form of the following punishments:

- Outing will be cut for boarder.
- Detention for extra study.
- Extra Physical Training

- **If 5 bad points are given to a child within span of a week, he / she is black listed and his / her name is announced at assembly.**
- A Yellow Card given at assembly means warning of expulsion. A Red Card received at assembly after this second warning. A second red card means expulsion. Students are expected to follow a high moral code of conduct. The school renders adequate guidance and counseling towards following good behaviour and high ethical life. If any students break rules or indulges in anti social activity. He / She will be liable for disciplinary action and expulsion from the school. If a child is expelled the fees already paid will be forfeited. No dialogue will be entertained in this regard.
- Within one academic term i.e within a 4 month working period, if the bad marks given to him / her amount to 15 points, he / she is suspended for 2 weeks from the school. This suspension is recorded in his / her file and will be reflected in his / her school life. One suspension plus 15 points accumulated in one term will be punished by expulsion.
- In case of damage to any property, if nobody takes responsibility mass fine will be imposed, 5 times more than actual price of asset.

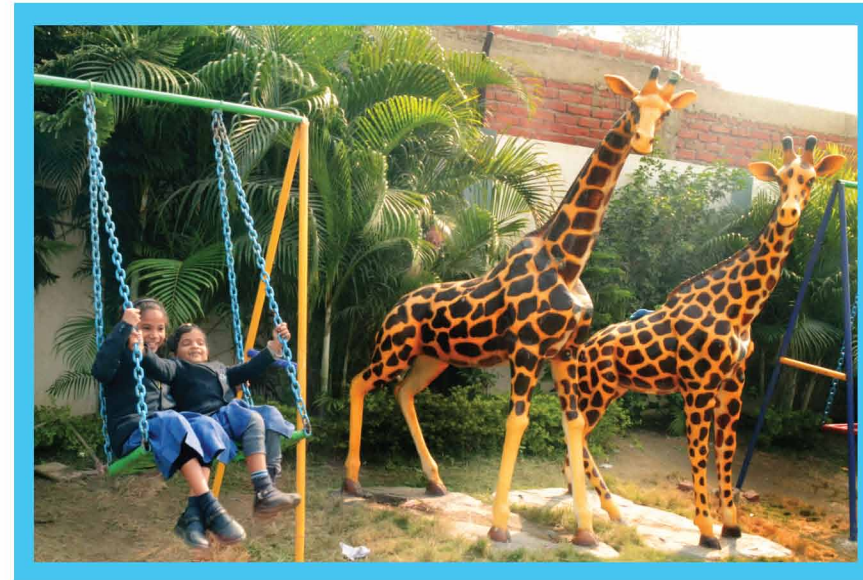
